The following updates/ revisions are noted and in effect:

Preface: Additions:

Location - 15041 Higgins Road

Publishing Updates via Website- In addition to annual meetings, Wetmore Community Cemetery Incorporated will use reasonable available means to notify members of changes in policies and procedures and general updates via mail, email and our website (See Article 16). To reduce costs, we ask all members and families to visit: <https://wetmorecemetery.com/> to access the most updated documents, By-Laws and/or pertinent changes affecting the cemetery.

Definitions: Additions:

Cinerarium- a place to receive the ashes of the cremated dead (Niche).

Columbarium- a structure of vaults lined with recesses for cinerary urns.

Article Four - Dues/Maintenance Fees – 4.01, 4.02, 4.03.4.04, 4.09 Removed.

Article Six – Duties of Officers and Directors 6.01, 6.02, 6.04 “checks in excess of five hundred (\$500) dollars” – omitted, (All checks must have two signatures). 6.03 The Secretary... may sign checks.

Article Ten – Meetings - 10.01 Notice shall be sent... “facsimile transmission”, Removed. Changed to, “in person, by email, text, or mail.”

Article Sixteen - Rules and Regulations: Additions:

16.04 Grave must be opened/closed by an approved professional employed in that specific business full-time and was approved previously by this organization and agreed to conform to cemetery rules and direction.

16.07 Markers must be a minimum of ten inches (10”) width by twenty-two (22”) Length by four inches (4”) thick in order to best survive the weight of maintenance equipment loads without damage.

Article Twenty Two – Burials: Additions:

22.04 All in-ground cremations require liners and may be either concrete or composite commensurate to approved funeral industry standard.

22.05 Regardless of previous purchases, if no headstone is present, owners or their designated representative must provide WCCI either a 30-Day refundable deposit (price to be set/raised by Board vote) or a “paid in full” receipt from a professional headstone company. If headstone is placed, owner or their designated representative must provide WCCI proof Date of Death (DoD) etching is paid in full prior to burial.

Hear ye, Hear ye, one and all, these By-Laws drafted by the Wetmore Community Cemetery Incorporated elected Board of Directors, adopted by majority vote of a quorum, at the annual meeting of the active members of the Wetmore Community Cemetery Corporation on 15th day of April, 2023, therefore nullifies and replaces all other By-Laws, rules, regulations, policies, procedures and any other verbal or written agreements are thereby null and void from this date forward!

By our signatures affixed below we are the Officers and Board of Directors at this time, swear that the statement above is true and correct, and with pride and honor present this to be our best effort, based on our knowledge, research of laws and experience. Our endeavor is to protect the past, present and future of the Wetmore Community Cemetery. So that all our loved ones interred there now may rest in peace forever, as we may also.
